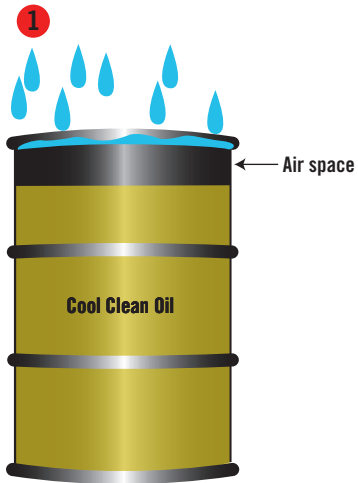
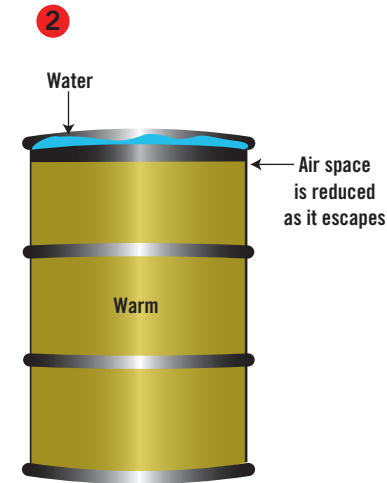


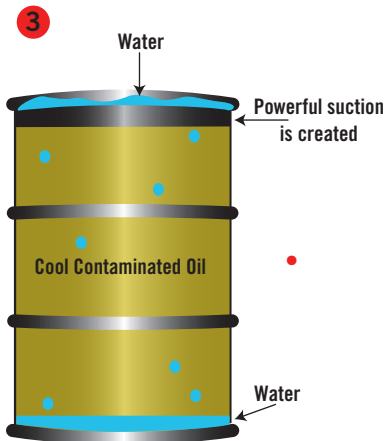
DID YOU KNOW DRUMS BREATHE?



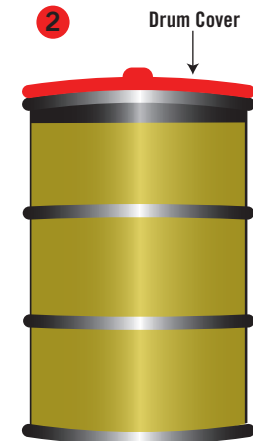
If the drum is placed outside, rain or snow settles on top of the drum.



When the surrounding area's temperature rises, the oil expands and air in the drum escapes.

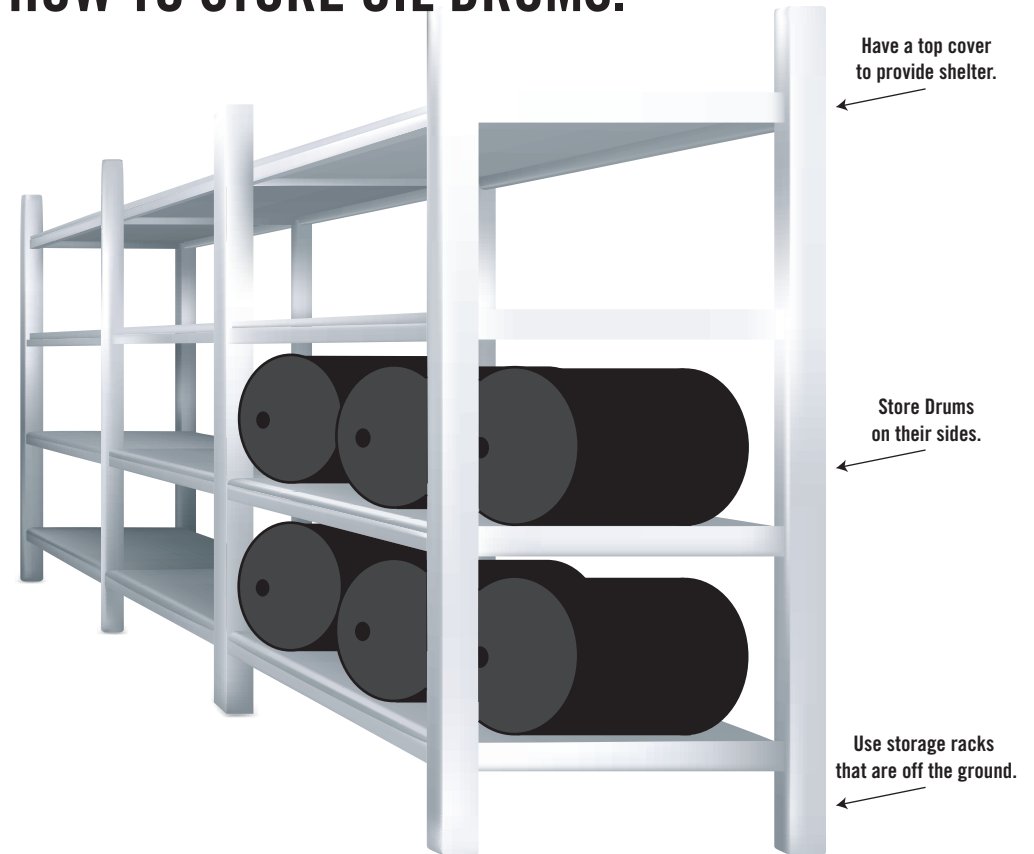


When the oil and surrounding temperature cools down, water is drawn inside the drum leading to contamination.



Use a drum cover to prevent contamination.

HOW TO STORE OIL DRUMS.



- Install shelving that adequately protects all containers, and store drums on their sides.
- The storage area should be well ventilated.
- The storage location should not be subject to external contamination such as dust, excess humidity or water.
- Store drums in the 3 – 9 position.

According to law, **BOSS LUBRICANTS will accept drum returns based on the following requirements:** "empty container" means a container that contains less than 2.5 centimetres of the original contents or less than 3% of the original contents, whichever is the lesser amount. – *Transportation of Waste Regulations Act*
